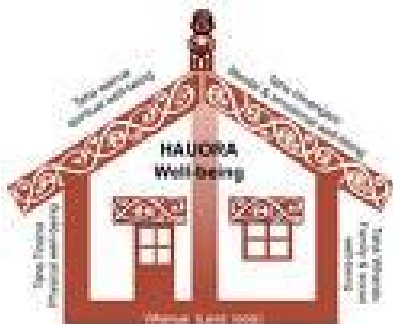

The SACS BRIEF INTERVENTION Worksheet

To follow are 10 steps that you can take with a young person to perform a brief intervention with the SACS. You may need to adapt them to suit various clinical situations.

- 1. Do the SACS**
- 2. Check in**
- 3. Score the SACS**
- 4. Review and discuss the individual items**
- 5. Provide positive feedback**
- 6. Choose one thing to change**
- 7. Brainstorm strategies for change**
- 8. Choose a strategy for change**
- 9. Agree on a goal**
- 10. Emphasise self-efficacy**
